The **1000 Hills Art Project** holds a bimonthly art show at Land of a Thousand Hills in Daleville as part of their events line-up to support the local art community, invest in our friends and residents of our local area, and increase funding for the Nkombo Island Project. www.nkmoboisland.org

The 1000 Hills Art Show Opening will be held the Second Friday of every other month from 6pm to 8pm at Land of a Thousand Hills in Daleville, should the artist want to hold a Meet & Greet for their opening. Each show will run a duration of 2 months from the second Friday of that month.

20% of the artist's work in the show, that is sold during the 2 months, will go directly to the **1000 Hills Art Project** which will be given to the Nkombo Island Project. The remaining 80% will go to the artist. Any sales made during the 2 month show will be recorded and the artist will be given the full amount at the end of the show or during the show, as requested, and the artist will donate back 20% which will be given directly to the Project (a tax deduction for the artist as a donation).

1. The artist will list price on the name card, that is required on each piece.
2. Please have a list of each piece of artwork with details and price to be given to Michelle at Land of a Thousand Hills the night of the Opening.
3. Please bring a 8" x 10" framed information sheet on your show and yourself to be hung with your art.

The artist is encouraged to publicize the [1000 Hills Art Project](#) for the duration of their show in any outlets and personal contacts that they have available to them. Any assistance in publicizing your Art Show Opening would be greatly appreciated as well.

The Nkombo Island Project donation goes directly to the Anglican Church Women's Union in Cyangugu, Rwanda. The Women's Union uses those funds to buy porridge for the children of Nkombo Island and to build the school.
